

Featuring the latest information about literacy across Texas and the country.

Corpus Christi Literacy Rates

More than 50,000 adults in Corpus Christi do not have a high school diploma or G.E.D. and more than 17% read below the 5th grade level.

In Nueces County, **33% of adults** lack basic literacy skills.

This problem is a vital concern to professional, education, civic, religious, and volunteer groups in our community.

U.S. Literacy Rates

Population with low literacy:

- 1. New Mexico 29.1%
- 2. California 28.4%
- 3. Texas 28.2%
- 4. Mississippi 28%
- 5. Louisiana 27.1%
- 6. New York 24.4%
- 7. Alabama 23.9%
- 8. Florida 23.7%
- 9. Georgia 23.6%
- 10. Arizona 23.4%

Texas Literacy Rates

- **28.2% of adults** in Texas have low literacy.
- Texas ranks 48 out of 50 in the United States.
